

# Tsartlip Day Camp Note / 2018

Tsartlip Summer Day Camp 2018/ July 9<sup>th</sup> to Aug 15<sup>th</sup>, Monday to Wednesday.  
The Tsartlip summer day camp schedule will be Monday to Wednesday from 10am- 3pm unless there is a special event. The summer student program will be responsible for the running of the camp. This year will be limited to 60 participants (first come first served), please notice the priority will go to community members and those that are reside in the community.

Location: Tsartlip Park Field/Ages: 6- 12, please notice a child have to be turning 6 by July 9<sup>th</sup> yrs 2018 in order for her/him to be accepted to the day camp. There will also be a fee \$10 for each participant. Please parents and guardians keep in mind that your child will only guarantee their spot after paying their day camp fee! Thank you for your understanding.

## **Just a reminder your child need!**

Lunches, Snacks, Water bottle, and Sunscreen!

There will be no lunches or snacks provided; the kids need to bring their own and don't forget they need their water bottle.

There will be a jug or cooler of water on site for the kids to re-fill their water bottle whenever they need it.

Day camp activities

The activities including water games balloon toss, water relays, sports like soccer, baseball, kickball, capture the flag, arts and crafts, duck x2 goose and water sports. The children will also have the opportunity to attend field trips. With the large numbers of children attending, we will only take the children attending day camp on a regularly basis.

The children must attend on regular basis to attend field trips.

If kids show up only field trip they may not be able to attend; it will depend on transportation room's availability. Priority will be given to those that attend regularly to day camp; however if you can get your own transportation then you can still attend.
