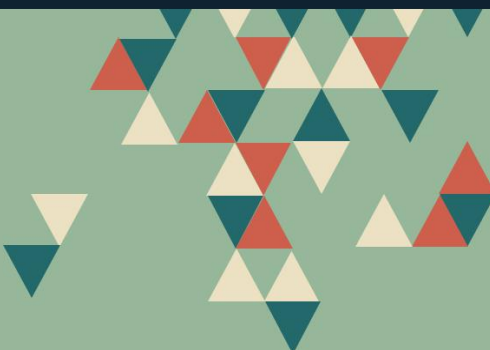

Art/Entrepreneurial Grant Funding Guideline

Grant information:

This project is a joint partnership between the Horner Foundation, Victoria Foundation and the Tsartlip First Nation. This funding will provide small, accessible grants to artists and entrepreneurs in the Tsartlip First Nation community.

The grants can be used to:

- Assist with the purchase of a piece of equipment that will help the artist or entrepreneur further their work in that area
- Pay for a course fee – the course must contribute to the artist or entrepreneur’s skills in that field
- Pay for a Certification or membership fee (these must contribute the field identified in this application)
- Help purchase of materials for an artistic project e.g. wool for weaving, wood for carving, supplies for painting, sewing, knitting, or other crafts in the artist’s chosen field
- Rental space to work for art creation or business
- Help with development of a business plan for the artist or entrepreneur’s business
- If your request does not fit under the listed guide line, please explain your request in detail

If you have any questions regarding if you are eligible for this grant, please discuss it with Project Coordinator, prior to completing the written form.

Grants **may not** be used to:

- Pay debts
- Purchase equipment or supplies not related to the project identified in the grant application
- Pay for expenses related to everyday living costs (purchase groceries, tobacco, car or other insurance, recreation costs)
- Or other costs that are not related to the completion of this project.
- Pay off previously purchased equipment or materials
- Used to fund any political party

How to apply:

There are three cycles in this pilot project

Winter 2019	Application Deadline:	January 31, 2019, 4:30 pm
Spring 2019	Application Deadline:	April 30, 2019, 4:30 pm
Fall 2019	Application Deadline:	October 31, 2019, 4:30 pm

If you wish to apply, please see the Project Coordinator for an application form. If you need assistance in filling out the application the project coordinator is available. The application must be dropped off prior to the deadline for that cycle.

After you apply:

Your application will be received by the Project Coordinator. You will be contacted if you are chosen to receive a grant. Successful applications will be notified within:

If your application is chosen you must:

- Keep receipts for any purchase you make with the grant funding, receipts must be provided to the Project Coordinator
- Maintain the deadline you have given for the project completion to the best of your ability, if you need to extend your finish date please see the project coordinator
- Notify the Project Coordinator if you need assistance with completing your project
- Attend the Achievement Celebration that is nearest to your date of project completion. This celebration will allow you to showcase your achievements, tell about your experience in this journey, and allow the committee and your family members to learn about your experience.

Grant Amount:

- 2 - \$1000.00 grants per cycle (Winter, Spring and Fall)
- 5 - \$500.00 grants (Winter, Spring cycle)
- 6 - \$500.00 grants (Fall cycle).
