Eligibility	 Eligible indigenous peoples must live in BC, be legally entitled to work in Canada, not be a full-time student, and have a strong desire to enter the trades workforce, plus are: unemployed or Precariously employed (under 20 hrs/wk) (i.e. low-skilled, under-employed) and actively seeking full-time employment
